

Cinema in the Kammergarten: A Touch of Baroque

The picturesque Privy Garden (Kammergarten) at the Lower Belvedere will this year, for the first time, be transformed into Vienna's most enchanting open-air cinema. From 1 to 20 August 2017, a superb programme of films will be shown daily at 9.30 pm, based around the theme "A Touch of Baroque". The films explore the age of Baroque or reveal "baroque" cinematography. They range from Sophia Coppola's "Marie Antoinette" and Derek Jarman's "Caravaggio", to Federico Fellini's "La Dolce Vita" and Jacques Tati's "Mon Oncle", to David Lynch's "Mulholland Drive" and Sally Potter's "Orlando".



Museum ticket is also cinema ticket! The two exhibitions *Klimt and Antiquity* and *Maria Theresa and the Arts* can be visited until 9 pm and there is a free guided tour between 8 and 9 pm. Cinema visitors can also look forward to a **chilled after-work atmosphere** with a summer bar and snacks.
